Boxing Legend Scott Ledoux has recently been diagnosed with ALS. ALS (short for amyotrophic lateral sclerosis) is a degenerative disease of the central nervous system, characterized by the death of the motor neurons. This results in a gradual, progressive weakness and wasting away of voluntary muscles, often leading to total paralysis. The life expectancy of a person living with ALS is usually two to five years from diagnosis. There is no known cause or cure for ALS, but advances in medical technology are allowing people with ALS to lead more productive lives. Research continues in hopes of discovering a cause and a cure.

Every week an average of two Minnesotans are diagnosed with ALS and two succumb to the disease. There are approximately 400 people living with ALS in Minnesota at any one time and 30,000 people nationwide. The ALS Association strives to lead the fight to cure and treat ALS through global, cutting-edge research, and to empower people with Lou Gehrig’s Disease and their families to live fuller lives by providing them with compassionate care and support.
